As they slip directly onto the forks, universal fit buckets stay on the machinery and are a lot less vulnerable to destruction. As opposed to the quick-tach container models, universal fit buckets are 50% deeper. This additional room makes them perfect for carrying irregular shaped loads like backfilling behind walls, tearing off roof trash, elevating roof gravel, moving large debris piles and broken up concrete.
